Information on the programs:

Woolworths NetSetGO is a fun, safe, social and active program for players turning 5 to 10. It gives children of all abilities a positive introduction to netball and teaches them the basic skills of the sport. Woolworths NetSetGO is divided into three tiers; **Net**, **Set** and **GO** meaning that participants develop skills at a pace that's right for their age and ability. Participants will take part in skill-based activities, minor games, and modified match play that will help them develop fundamental movement skills, as well as important social skills. The weekly program is coordinated by accredited coaches to ensure a quality experience for all participants.

The activity / skills program consists of 2 tiers - **Net** and **Set**. This program is designed for brand new players. The ages mentioned with each tier are not strict, more of a guideline for parents, centres and coaches.

The NetSetGO membership cost for the winter and spring 2026 seasons is \$99 (includes player insurance paid once per year) with an additional local club cost which will be notified by our club on our registration paperwork. Session day and time will be updated / advised once court availability is known at our training courts.

Participants are required to register their Netball Victoria Membership ("NVM") online in order to be able to participate. Payment to be made online at the time of registering. Players can register at any time during the season, subject to availability.

Participants are to wear comfortable clothing (NetSetGO t-shirt once received or a t-shirt, shorts or leggings and a warm top for cooler weather) and bring a drink bottle for Net & Set.

GO (6 to 10 years) – Competition

Be a part of modified netball games with a focus on fun and teamwork

The competition program consists of 1 tier – **GO**. This program is designed for brand new or existing players. The ages mentioned with each tier are not strict, more of a guideline for parents, centres and coaches.

The **GO** competition program is incorporated into the LYVNA 9 and Under competition. Entry into this competition is done by registering through local clubs. Please contact our club to join one of our teams in the 9U competition. Minimum age requirement is that players must turn 6 prior to the last day of the current season playing.

The skills taught include:

- Catch, pass and throw a ball
- Pivot and change direction
- Play a basic game of netball
- Make new friends
- Take off and land
- Shoot for a goal
- Work and communicate as part of a team
- With an emphasis on FUN.
